Hon. Felicia Pitre was elected Dallas County District Clerk on November 6, 2014 and took office on January 1, 2015. Felicia has made protecting the personal information of litigants and their children a top priority. She worked with the Dallas County Commissioners court to identify \$500,000 in funds for a project to redact sensitive data including social security numbers, dates of birth, driver's license numbers and minor names from court records available to the public online.

Felicia has also made improving customer service a cornerstone of her administration. Under her leadership, the Juvenile courts successfully completed a one-year project to implement the courts' first ever modern case management system. In addition, Felicia expanded electronic filing to the criminal district courts making Dallas County the very first county in the state to offer eFiling of criminal documents and pleadings.

Felicia is native of Lake Charles, Louisiana and has lived in the Dallas area for nearly thirty years. Felicia is well known for her community involvement and volunteer activities assisting young families, the elderly, job-seekers and helping ex-offenders re-enter the job market. She is the former president of the Phillis Wheatley Neighborhood Association in South Dallas/Fair Park and can frequently be seen assisting in clean-up campaigns and beautification projects.
